Like the rock that stands against the tides
(someone who is resolute despite facing difficulties)

The distinctive skull of the hammerhead shark (*Sphyrna zygaena*) is believed to help detect prey, and to add lift like a hydrofoil, counteracting the downward push of the tail. Hammerheads are olive to dark grey, with a white underbelly, and grow to 4 metres. Large individuals can be dangerous to people.

INSTRUCTIONS

- From the 13th of December, collect a booklet (for the whole five-week challenge) or a weekly entry form from the library, or download a weekly entry form at gpl.govt.nz
- Start the reading challenge by borrowing books and audiobooks from the library, or eBooks and eAudiobooks at gpl.govt.nz
- Read (or ask a grown-up to read to you) for 10 minutes, and tick a circle in the booklet or weekly entry form; keep ticking one circle for every 10 minutes of reading
- Once you have read for 60 minutes (one hour) and completed the entry form, submit your entry at the library, or take a photo and upload it at gpl.govt.nz
- You can submit more than one entry each week. All entries submitted by Sunday each week go into a draw for a weekly mystery prize!
- To complete the challenge you need to read for five hours (300 minutes) in 10-minute slots, before Sunday 16th January 2022
- All entries go into a final draw to win a brand-new tablet!
- Keep reading, the more entries you submit the more chances you have to win!

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By submitting a completed entry form you agree that the information provided to HB Williams Memorial library is true, current, and complete.
2. The number of circles ticked on each entry must be a true representation of the number of ten-minute slots a person under 18 has spent reading or being read to by an adult.
3. Only overdue fees and charges may be waived. Replacement and administration costs for lost or damaged items cannot be waived.
4. HB Williams Memorial Library's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MANY BOOKS DO I NEED TO READ PER WEEK? As many as you like! One long book may take you more than one hour to read, or you may be able to read lots of shorter books in one hour.

CAN I READ FOR MORE THAN ONE HOUR PER WEEK? Yes! If you finish the one-hour weekly challenge, collect or download another weekly entry form to keep reading. You can submit as many weekly entries as you want.

HOW CAN I WIN ONE OF THE WEEKLY PRIZES? Submit your weekly entries in person during the library's opening hours, or upload a photo at gpl.govt.nz. All weekly entries received by 11.59pm each Sunday go in that week's draw (and in the final draw to win a brand-new tablet).

WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE WON A WEEKLY PRIZE? The weekly draw will take place every Tuesday starting 21st December 2021. The winners will be notified by phone or email on or before the following Friday.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I MISS SUNDAY'S DEADLINE? All weekly entries received after 11.59pm each Sunday will automatically go into the final draw to win a brand-new tablet.

WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE WON THE BRAND-NEW TABLET? The final draw will take place Tuesday 18th January 2022. The winner will be notified by phone or email on or before Friday 21st January 2022.

I AM NOT A LIBRARY MEMBER, CAN I STILL PARTICIPATE? Yes! If you are visiting our region, you can still submit your entries, but you must collect the prize at the library if you win, or ask someone local to collect it for you. If you live in Tairāwhiti | Gisborne Region you can become a library member. Go to Pukarau (the library front desk), or register online at gpl.govt.nz, or call 06 867 6709 for more information.

WHAT FEES CAN I READ AWAY? You can read away overdue fees and charges owing on your library card, or a family member's card. We will take \$1 off your fees for every ten minutes you read.

WHEN WILL MY OVERDUE FEES BE WAIVED? Overdue fees and charges will be waived by Friday 21st January 2022 at the latest.

THERE ARE OVERDUE FEES ON MY CARD AND ON AN ADULT'S CARD. CAN I READ AWAY BOTH? Yes. You just need to write both library membership numbers in your entry form.

I HAVE LOST SOME BOOKS. CAN I READ AWAY THE REPLACEMENT COSTS TOO? No. The replacement and administration costs for lost or damaged items cannot be reduced by participating in this reading challenge.
